SUBJECT: INTIMATION OF PEACEFUL PUBLIC RALLY, REQUEST FOR NOC.

This is with reference to your application number ISB/pres./258/2022 dated 18-11-2022, submitted regarding holding of Public Rally on 19th November, 2022 start from Koral Chowk, Islamabad to Chak Beli Morr, Rawat Islamabad. It is to inform here that Section 144 Cr.PC. is imposed on all kind of public gatherings in Federal Capital including in & around Red Zone by this office vide order dated 23rd September, 2022.

2. The directions of the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan in Constitutional Petition No. 2 of 2022 has also been perused wherein, Honorable Supreme Court has directed that mechanism may be worked out with the political parties as to holding of rallies and the days and venue thereof.

3. The Honorable Islamabad High Court in W.P. No. 1082/2022 observed that political parties are expected to strictly comply with the regulations and restrictions prescribed in the interest of maintaining public order and maintenance of public order and imposition of reasonable restriction in the context of regulating exercising the right guaranteed under Article 16 of the Constitution is within exclusive domain of executive authorities' vis a vis Article 15 of the Constitution.

4. The instant application has been examined and permission is hereby granted on the following terms and conditions:-


- i. The permission will be valid for route from Koral chowk, Islamabad via Islamabad Express Highway till Chak Belli More Rawat, Rawalpindi through T-cross Islamabad on 19th November, 2022 at 12:00.
- ii. Since Section 144 is imposed on gathering of persons in Islamabad including Red Zone vide order dated 23-09-2022 of the District Magistrate, the permission granted to the undersigned as organizer will be in exception (one time only) to the above notification. And it will only be valid for the route from Koral chowk, Islamabad via Islamabad Express Highway till Chak Belli More Rawat, Rawalpindi through T-cross Islamabad on 19th November, 2022. Every type of gathering / rally apart from this place will be an illegal assembly and action will be taken against the undersigned in case of violation.
- iii. In case of any untoward / unfortunate incident or happening this permission will be considered withdrawn itself and the undersigned will be held responsible directly and vicariously.
- iv. This gathering shall not disturb or disrupt the fundamental rights of citizens of Islamabad and adjoining areas e.g. Right to Freedom of Movement (Article 15), Right to Freedom of trade and business (Article 18) and Right to Education (Article 25-A). Hence no roads shall be blocked. In the instant case, particularly the Islamabad Express Highway and G.T. road will not be blocked.



- v. If because of violation of any term/condition, situation arise which may resort to use of force, then undersigned will be responsible for any causality, if occurs.
- vi. Access to public/private property shall not be obstructed by the participants.
- vii. Clear right-of-way for fire brigades, ambulances, and other emergency vehicles/personnel shall be ensured by the undersigned.
- viii. No infants / children under the age of 18 years shall be allowed and the organizers take responsibility on this account except with their lawful guardians. Welfare and safety of such infants shall be the responsibility of the guardians and it will be ensured by undersigned.
- ix. Participants shall not enter any restricted area or obstruct any public / private thoroughfare during the movement of rally.
- x. Undersigned undertake that they will respect the fundamental human rights of other stakeholders and public at large during the said gathering.
- xi. Undersigned shall be responsible for any human injury/ health issue caused during the movement of rally due to internal arrangements. Any person of unsound mind not to be allowed to participate in rally.
- xii. For safety of the general public, maintenance of law and order at the venue, the ICT Police and Law Enforcement Agencies shall not be obstructed to check/ search of any vehicle/ person coming to participate in the rally.
- xiii. The undersigned will sit with ^{ICT Police} ~~SP/Police~~ and will chalk out traffic plan for movement of vehicles of participant so that no blockage of any road takes place. The plan will be adhered to by the organizers / participants of the event as smooth traffic flow for the residents of ICT shall not be obstructed.
- xiv. No damage shall be caused to the Public or Private Property and in case of any such damage, the undersigned will be held responsible and will pay the cost of the damages occurred during this period due to an act, omission, failure or negligence of any of the participants.
- xv. No object of lethal or non-lethal force including batons of any size would be wielded by any participant of the rally nor shall any participant indulge in violence or clashes. In case of any such incidence of clashes/ violence the undersigned shall be held responsible.
- xvi. It is reiterated that Section 144 is imposed on gathering of persons in Islamabad including Red Zone and more specifically no participants will be allowed to enter in & around Red Zone.
- xvii. The undersigned shall take responsibility that the participants shall not illegally move beyond the identified route, any violation of this and resultant consequences shall be the responsibility of the organizer / undersigned.
- xviii. Anti-state, anti-religious, or anti ideology of Pakistan slogans or speeches shall not be made by the speakers or any of the participants.
- xix. The undersigned shall also provide the under taking by each of the speaker that he has read over this undertaking and the speaker will be personally and directly responsible/ liable for his act/speech or any utterance in a gathering / rally. Further he will also be responsible for any act, damage or violence committed in pursuance of his speech, act, utterance or indication.
- xx. Speaker or any other participant shall not propagate any opinion, word, indication or act in any manner prejudicial to the ideology of Pakistan, or the sovereignty, integrity or security of Pakistan, or morality, or the maintenance of public order, or the integrity or independence of the State Institutions, or which defames or brings into ridicule the State Institutions, in any manner whatsoever.



- xxi. The speaker or any other person shall personally be responsible for any act, word, visible representation, which defame any person, institution or organization and organizers will be vicariously liable for such defamation.
- xxii. Effigy/flag of any political or religious party shall not be burnt.
- xxiii. Weapons/firearms of any kind shall not be taken in the rally.
- xxiv. The use of decks/speakers shall comply with the provisions of West Pakistan Amplifier Ordinance 1965.
- xxv. Search of the participants shall be the responsibility of the undersigned. Participants shall only be allowed to join rally after thorough security check.
- xxvi. Threat perception/ source reports shall be shared with the organizer / undersigned from time to time by the ICT Administration on which the undersigned shall take enhanced security measures.
- xxvii. All rules and regulations, municipal bye laws shall be strictly adhered too.
- xxviii. Streamers / Banners shall only be installed after approval from MCI. Banners or streamers containing public message shall not be removed / obstructed.
- xxix. The undersigned shall make sure that the participants coming from outside Islamabad shall abide by the conditions under which permission will be given.
- xxx. Littering at/near the venue of the event shall not be permitted.
- xxxi. No intoxicant or any banned substance of consumption on shall be served/allowed at the venue.
- xxxii. Details of Private Security arrangements shall be provided by the Organizers to the SSP (Operations), ICT, 12 hours before the start of the rally.
- xxxiii. The event shall conform to the cultural values of Pakistan.
- xxxiv. Any instructions regarding security and public order issued regarding the event by the District Administration or ICT Police shall be complied by the undersigned in case of any disorder.
- xxxv. In case of violation of any of the above terms and conditions, the undersigned shall be liable to face legal proceedings and NOC shall automatically stand cancelled.
